HOW IT STARTED

A few men, a field, and a willingness to pray.

No building. No budget. Just brothers who decided to show up for each other and for God. They prayed for their marriages, their kids, their work, their battles — and slowly men who came in guarded started to open up.

Then the wives came. Then the kids. Living rooms became sanctuaries: a guitar in the corner, a couch full of kids, a room of people laying hands on whoever needed prayer that night. Nobody left a stranger.

A people who have been loved well can't keep it to themselves. So we went where the need was — to the homeless, to men and women in recovery, to anyone who would never walk into a building on Sunday but might meet Jesus on a Tuesday night.

WHAT WE DO

Six ways to gather, serve, and grow.

I Praise & Worship Nights

Regular gatherings in homes — worship, testimonies, prayer, and a meal. Anyone welcome.

II Family Nights

Worship, food, and fellowship for the whole household. Kids are the point, not a problem.

III Feeding the Homeless

Hot meals, clean clothes and shoes, and church on the grass — prayer with people by name.

IV Regeneration

Walking alongside men and women in recovery — freedom from hurts, habits, and hang-ups through Christ.

V Men's Breakfasts

Saturday mornings: bacon, coffee, the Word, and men telling the truth to each other.

VI Retreats & Small Groups

Cookouts, dinners, and weekends away where surface-level turns into real.

Who it's for: anyone. You don't need to belong to a church, know the songs, or have your life together.
